James' Sermon on the Mount: Rebuking a 'Worldly - Dead Church'

²² But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves. ²³ For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like a man observing his natural face in a mirror; ²⁴ for he observes himself, goes away, and immediately forgets what kind of man he was.

²⁵ But he who looks into the perfect law of liberty and continues *in it,* and is not a forgetful hearer but a doer of the work, this one will be blessed in what he does. (Luke 6:20-45)

'Law of Liberty' – Messianic Teachings – Spirit led Doctrines = The Faith

You are Apostle -Ambassadors - Messianic Judges! What Did Jesus Command?

²⁶ If anyone among you thinks he is religious, and does not bridle his tongue but deceives his own heart, this one's religion *is* useless. (Luke 6:27-28...Chp 3)

²⁷ Pure and undefiled religion before God and the Father is this:

- 1. to visit orphans and widows in their trouble, [Chapter 2]
- 2. and to keep oneself [as a Messianic Judge] unspotted from the world.
- ἄσπιλος aspilŏs, as´-pee-los; unblemished, without taint, corrupt[Chp 4]
- What Does James mean by 'unspotted by the world'? (Luke 6:29-35)

2 My brethren, do not hold the faith [Teachings/Commands] of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Lord (?) of glory, with partiality. ('the faith' - Picking and Choosing)

² For if there should come into your assembly (*sunagogue*- Life) a man with gold rings, in fine apparel, and there should also come in a poor man in filthy clothes, ³ and you pay attention to the one wearing the fine clothes and say to him, "You sit here in a good place," and say to the poor man, "You stand there," or, "Sit here at my footstool,"

[Judging by 'Status Card' - Outward Observations: Creates a Prideful/False People)

⁴ have you not shown partiality among yourselves, and become judges with evil thoughts (*reasonings*)?

'Unspotted Judges 4 Christ': Luke 6:37-38

- 1. 'Judge NOT...' [As the Rich/World/Pharisees Do: Turning people away from Him]
- 2. 'Condemn NOT...'Callous/hard'- Rightly 'Deserve' rather than 'Come to Jesus'
- 3. 'Forgive...' Offenses, Mistakes, failures, struggles, open sin: Matt. 18:21-35
- 4. 'Give...' "When the Spirit leads: Give your ALL as Christ Gave His ALL"

⁵ Listen, my beloved brethren:

Has God not chosen the poor of this world *to be* rich in faith and heirs of the kingdom which He promised to those who love Him? (**Luke 6:20-23**)

- 1. In Your Obedience...You will be Poor...but rich in faith (You KNOW)
- 2. B/c of Your Obedience... you will receive your Kingdom Inheritance.

⁶ But you have dishonored the poor man. [Jesus ALWAYS embraced Imperfection] Do not the rich oppress you and drag you into the courts? (Luke 6:24-26)

⁷ Do they not blaspheme that noble name by which you are called?

So Why is this Important? What is the 'take home from this?'

- 1. These men watched Jesus as THEIR Example To be the Church's Example
- Christ's Ambassadors -Leaders of the Churches were failing miserably
- Christ's Churches were following...failing Miserably: Dead Faith
- James is Rebuking them and Holding them Accountable.

- 3. Our # 3 Role is Allowing Ourselves to be Prepared for the Kingdom

The Obedient Believer in Christ IS being Prepared to be a Messianic Judge:

(Christ 'Judges' through His Church – Doctrines – Leadership & Believers today)
