- (5) Meet the Parents: (Credentials as coming from 'Good Jewish stock')
- (6a) 'righteous before God' "God's Plan 4 Man's Place in His Presence."

FAITH: "Belief in Heard illuminated Word (Justification- OT Style) – Resolve to Trust & Obey

FAITH 4 Relationship (Position – Imputed Righteousness) OBEDIENCE 4 Spiritual Fellowship (Condition –Kingdom In., Place/Pos., Blessing.)

- (7) This was a 'Big Problem' for the Prophecy that needed fulfilled (Mal. 3:1)
- **(8-9)** There were specific instructions steps orders divisions: for serving before God in this way. [*Incense* represents the prayers of the people]
- (10) The people were praying in the outside court:
- ➤ Who were the people?...God's People I______
- What was the spiritual condition of God's people @ this time?

400 years Prior to this (condition probably became worse) Malachi Warns:

NKJV Introduction:

MALACHI, a prophet in the days of Nehemiah, directs his message of judgment to a people plagued with corrupt priests, wicked practices, and a false sense of security in their privileged relationship with God. Sing the question-and-answer method, Malachi probes deeply into their problems of hypocrisy, infidelity, mixed marriages, divorce, false worship, and arrogance. So sinful has the nation become that God's words to the people no longer have any impact. For four hundred years after Malachi's ringing condemnations, God remains silent. Only with the coming of John the Baptist (prophesied in 3:1) does God again communicate to His people through a prophet's voice.

"A multitude of the People...living in open sin...praying about what?"

[Does a believer live however they want... and remain in Spiritual Fellowship with God? Consequences?]

(11-12) Why the troubled – fearful response?

Angels often meant 'Judgment': Exodus – Sodom/Gomorrah – David – Daniel

(13-14) This 50ish year old man was Praying as he represented Israel:

- 1. Joy and gladness many will rejoice at his birth (Anticipated Hope)
- 2. 'great in the sight of the Lord' no strong drink/wine: fully sanctified to God
- 3. 'filled with Holy Spirit' OT Style (Life @ Conception) Mal. 3:1
- 4. 'turn many of the children of Israel to the Lord **their** God' [seeking/empty]
- 5. 'go before Him in the spirit and power of Elijah' –[att./boldness facing apostacy]
- 6. 'turn the hearts of the fathers to the children' Spiritually Reprobate Parents
- 7. 'disobedient to the wisdom of the just'- disobedience means they 'KNOW'/Raised TO KNOW...will REPENT & RESPOND to God's TRUTH from the FAITHFUL.
- 8. 'to make ready a people prepared for the Lord.' –
- Who is the 'people'? God's People....
- What does 'Prepared' mean? [Praying outside the temple...while Themselves their Families Heritage live in open sin against God?]

A Messenger of Salvation had COME: But it was to 'God's People' 1st

They 'KNEW' & Ignored that "Judgment Comes when the King Comes"

THIS HAS NEVER Changed...

Rev. 22:12 "And behold, I am coming quickly, and My reward *is* with Me, to give to every one according to his work. ¹³ I am the Alpha and the Omega, *the* Beginning and *the* End, the First and the Last."

The Challenge this Christmas is this:

"When all are gathered...(It's LOUD)...enjoying one another...Family Traditions...Meals...Activities....

ASK yourself the Question:

"Are we a people prepared for Coming of the Lord?"

I John 2:28 "And now, little children, abide in Him, that when He appears, we may have confidence and not be ashamed before Him at His coming."
